Lambeth & Croydon Foodbank provide essential community services to people in crisis. This could include small DIY projects, painting, working as part of a team on larger projects, both inside the warehouse and outside on the grounds surrounding it. Alongside being a voice for change in your community, you can make a real difference to people's lives providing vital help and support in your local community.

We would be looking for a commitment of approximately one half day, once a week between 9 am to 3pm on weekdays when a project is ongoing if possible.

What you will be doing

- A variety of tasks including small jobs that require specific knowledge or expertise such as fixing light sockets, painting, re-hanging and repairing shelving, fixtures or fittings.
- Working on projects in the grounds of the Foodbank such as making raised flowerbeds to grow herbs and vegetables.
- Creating pathing, bike sheds, sheltered covering for storage for our supermarket cages and crates.
- Putting up shelving, creating cupboards, hanging whiteboards and other items on walls.

- Ability to work alone or in a team.
